



## Lake Tahoe Nevada State Park Trail Workshop

Nevada Division of State Parks (NDSP) is sponsoring a trail workshop to help plan the future of the trails in Lake Tahoe Nevada State Park as part of the update of the General Management Plan. NDSP encourages all trail users to attend this workshop. The goal is to gather ideas and feedback after review of the DRAFT map.

NDSP will also accept comments on winter recreation at their Spooner Lake facility. The current winter cross country ski and snowshoe concession contract has not been renewed and public feedback is encouraged on the future of the site for winter recreation.

A Draft Trail Map for the 14,000+ acre Lake Tahoe Nevada State Park will be presented at the meeting for review and comment. The map will include Sand Harbor, State Route 28 corridor [including Hidden Beach], Spooner Lake, Van Sickle Bi-State Park, and Marlette/Hobart backcountry. The 13,000+ acre Marlette Hobart backcountry receives the most trail use and the area contains several miles of trails including the Tahoe Rim Trail, the American Discovery Trail and the Flume Trail.

Staff from the Tahoe Rim Trail Association and the U. S. Forest Service will also be there to answer your questions.
